Prior to 1938, colloidal silver and silver products were prescribed by physicians, but the advent of antibiotics and the growth of the drug industry, saw the medical use of colloidal silver cease.

Today the use of colloidal silver is seeing a popular resurgence, but what is it?

The definition of colloid is 'particles which remain in a suspended state, without dissolving in a solution'. Colloidal silver is the liquid suspension of microscopic particles of silver, in purified water.
